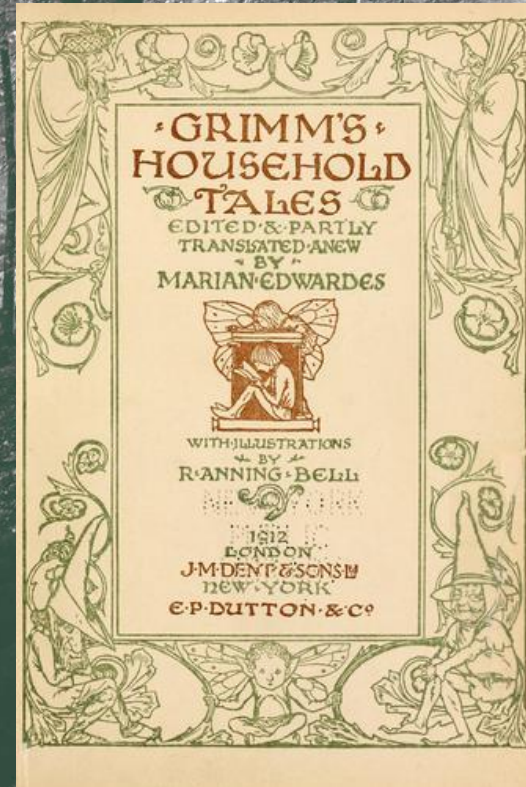

Image of the forest between Deifeld and Titmaringhausen



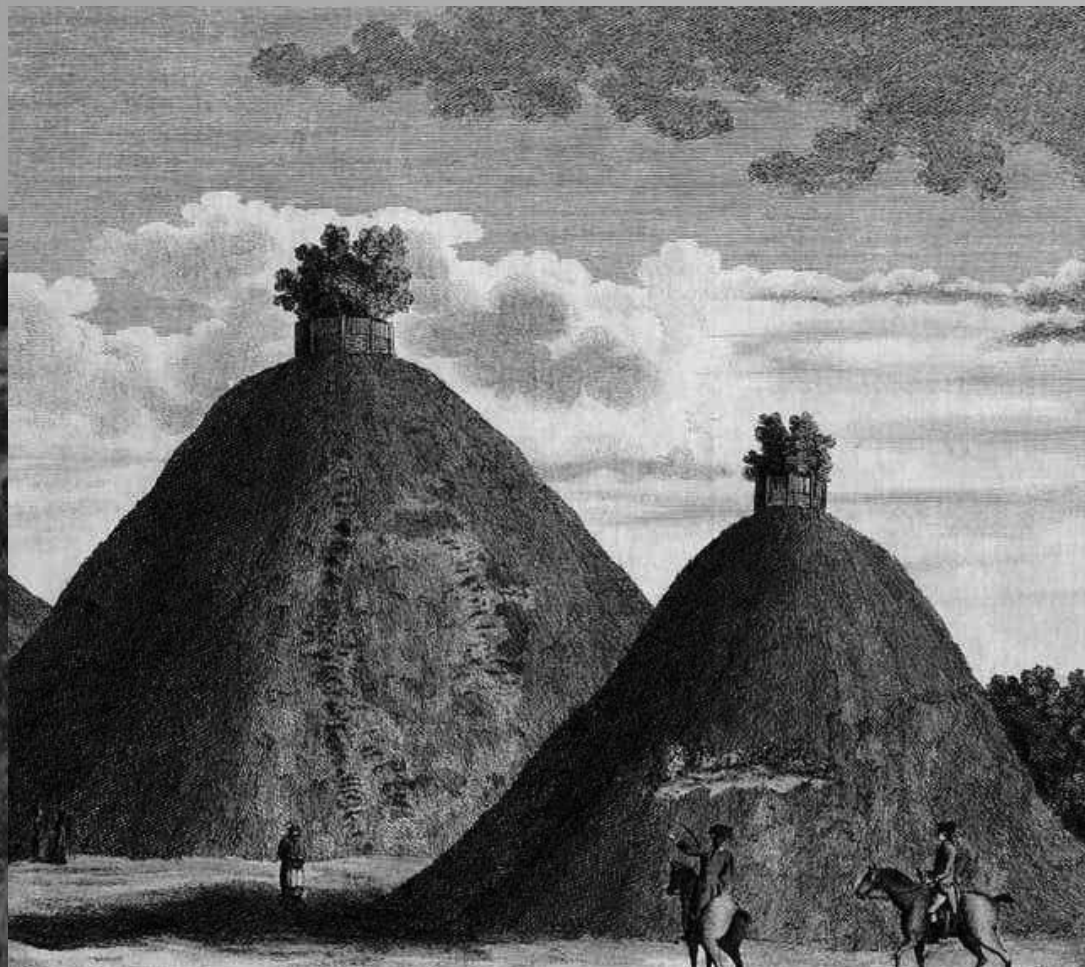

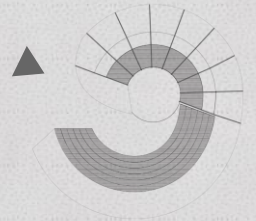
FLOOR PLAN



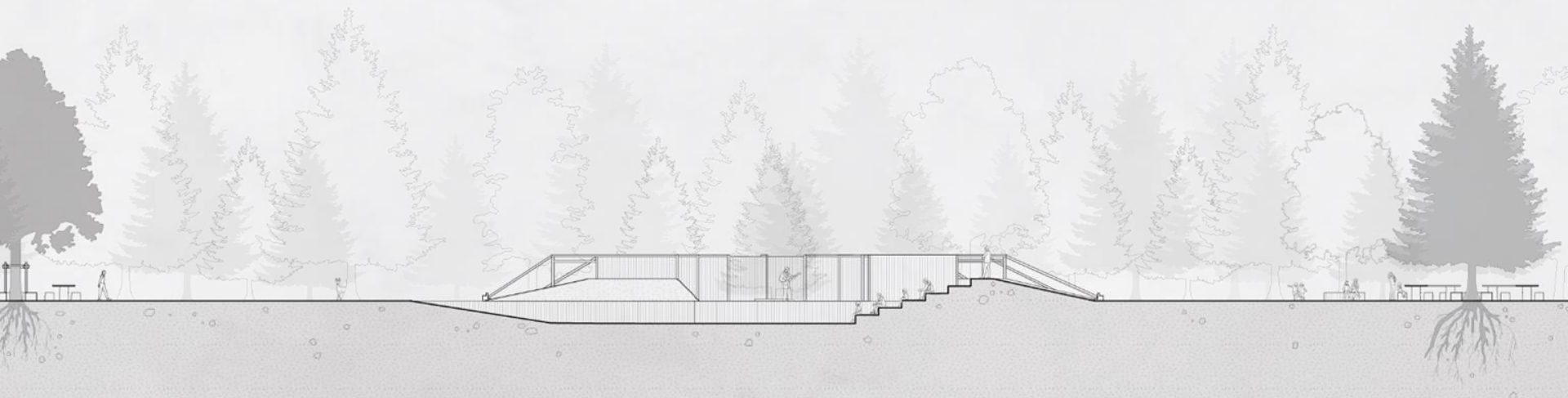


NORTH ELEVATION

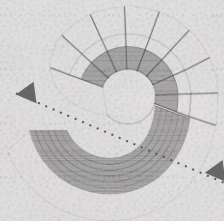


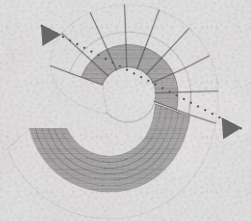
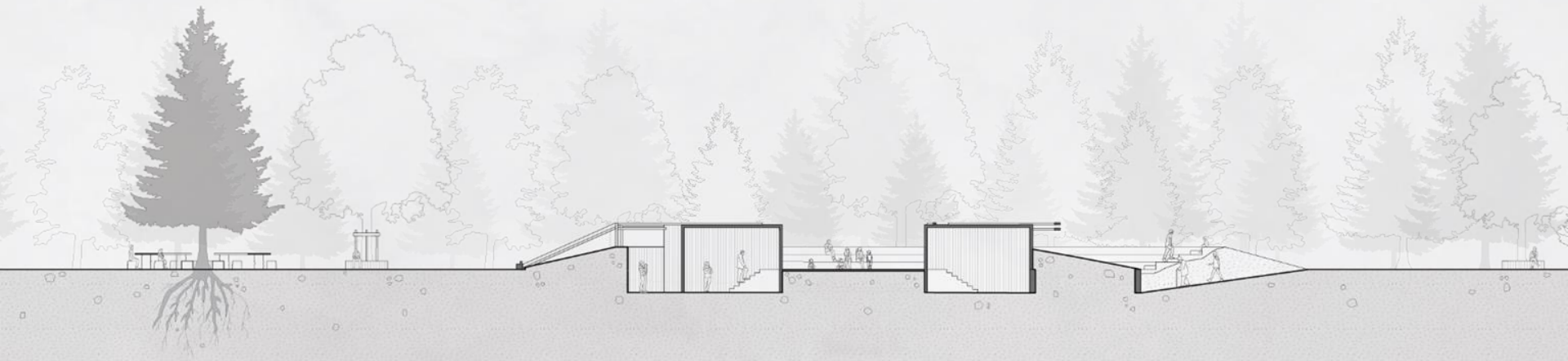




Wayfinding Trees "Findungsbaum"





Climate Smart Forestry - *increase or stabilize carbon storage (carbon stocks) and changing rate at which carbon is absorbed by trees (carbon sequestration)*



Hardwood trees store the most carbon and can include **oak trees, birch trees, and beech trees** which are all native to Germany. Even when a tree is cut down the wood still stores carbon until it is burned or decomposed.

50% of the dry weight of wood is stored carbon.

Forests **sequester** carbon

Wood products **store** carbon

Wood is a cleaner **substitute**

Sustain long-term forests.











Climate Change's effects on Germany


Milder Winters (less snow + shorter periods of frozen ground)

= an increase risk of negative impacts to soil which affect forest productivity and health.

Increase in bugs/pests in forests that can harm trees.

Monoculture Planting

Single species of trees means higher risk of disease spread.

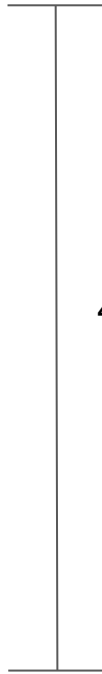

A 40m oak tree removes **6 tons** of Co2

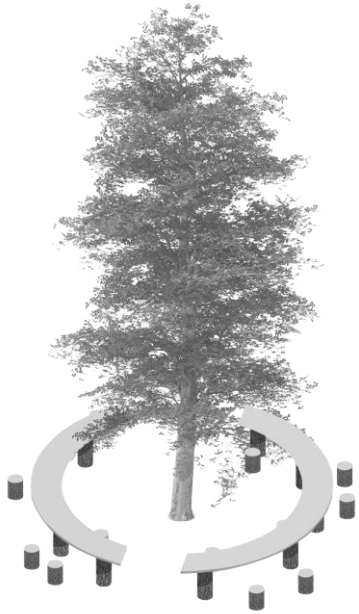
40m Beech tree can remove **7 tons** of Co2.

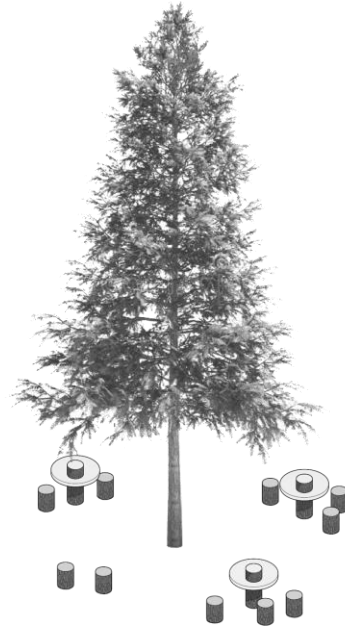

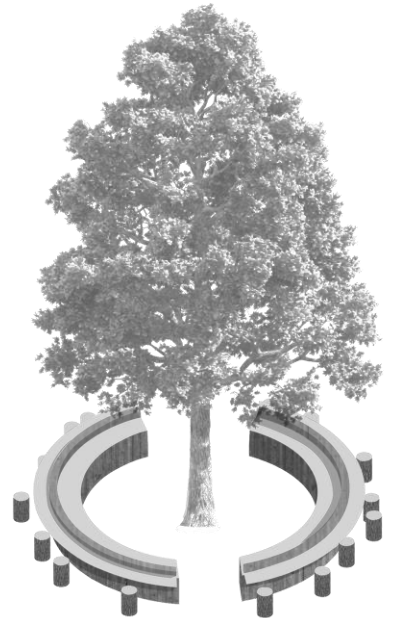
