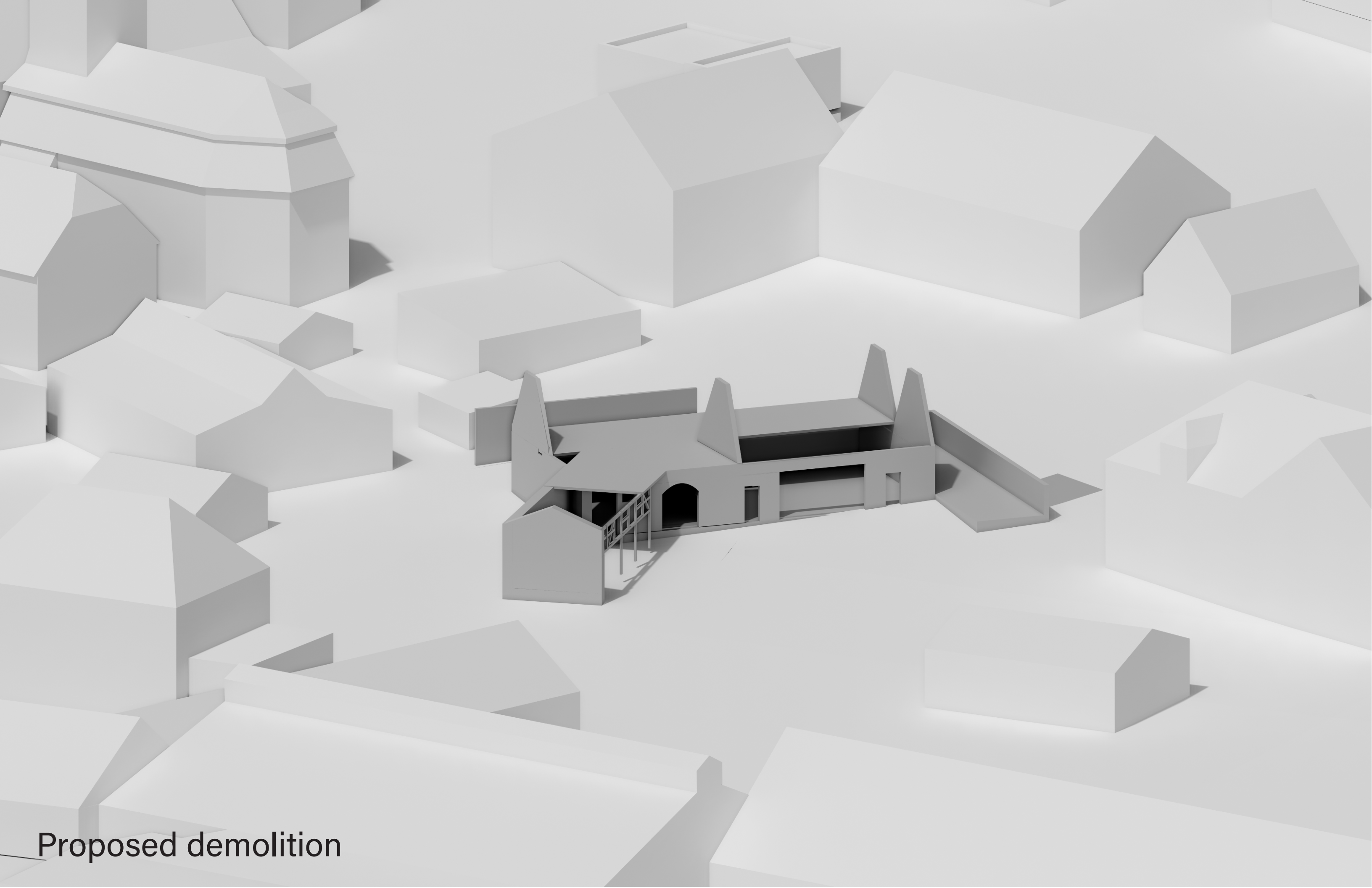




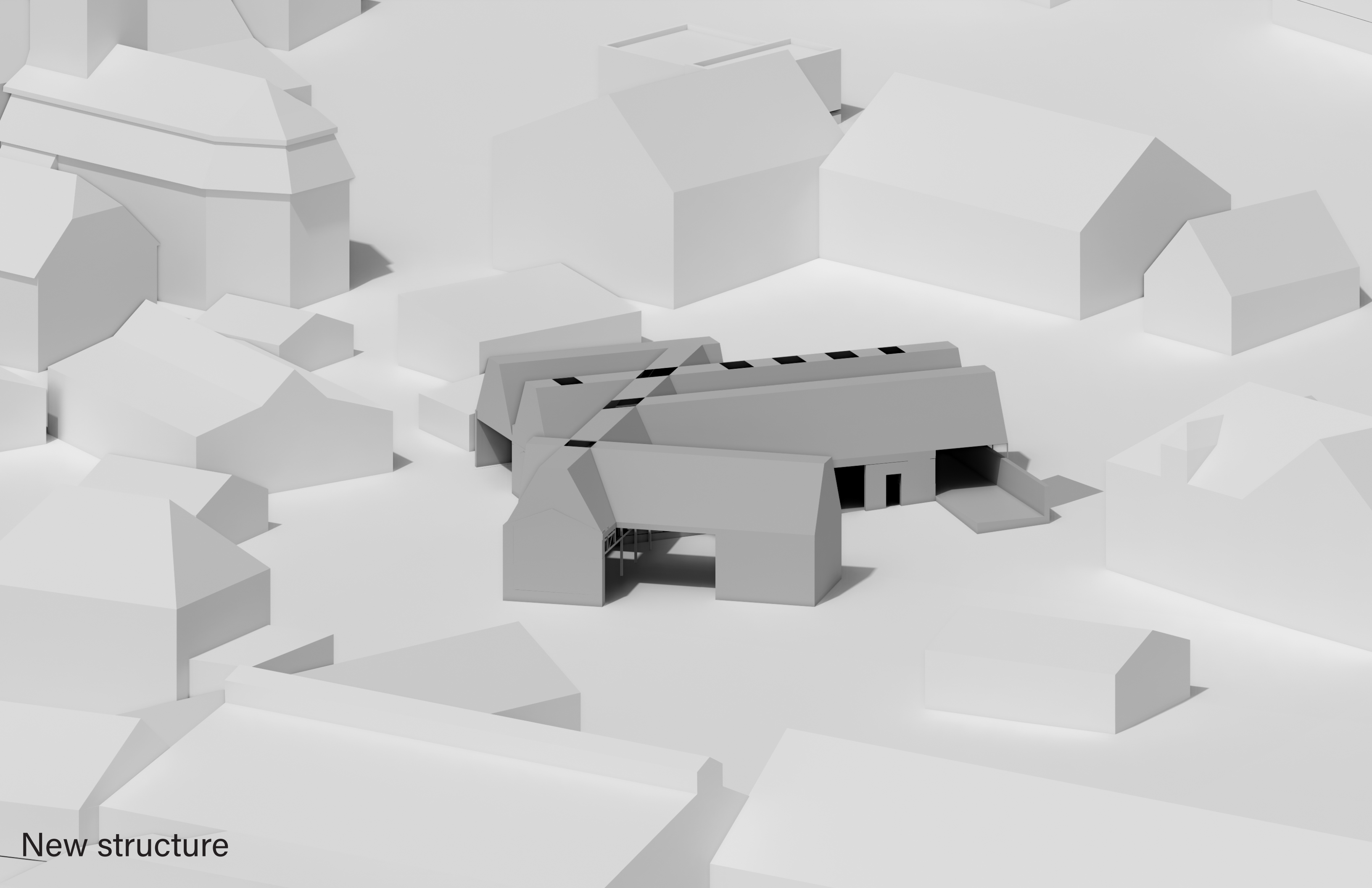




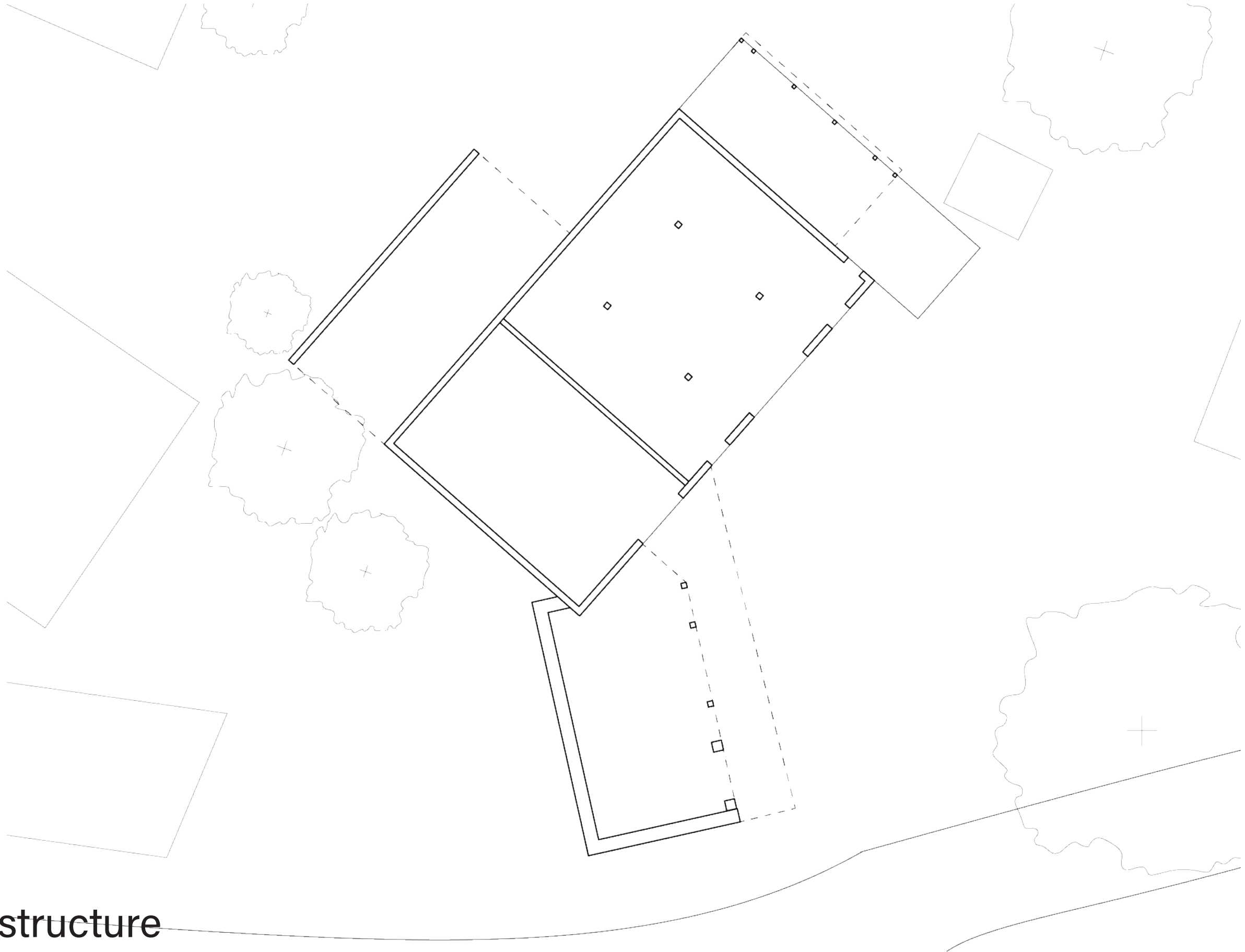
Existing structure



Proposed demolition



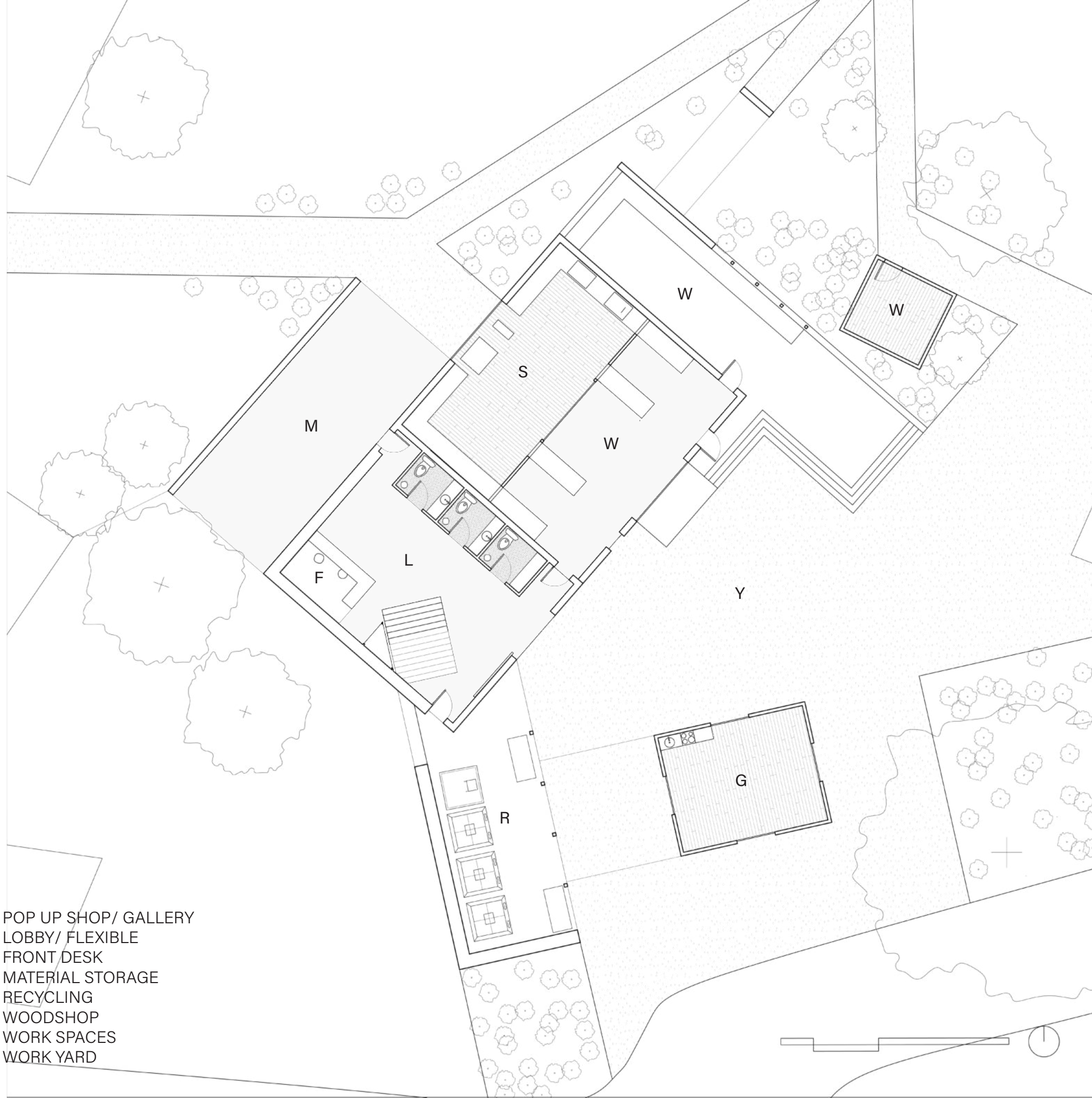
New structure

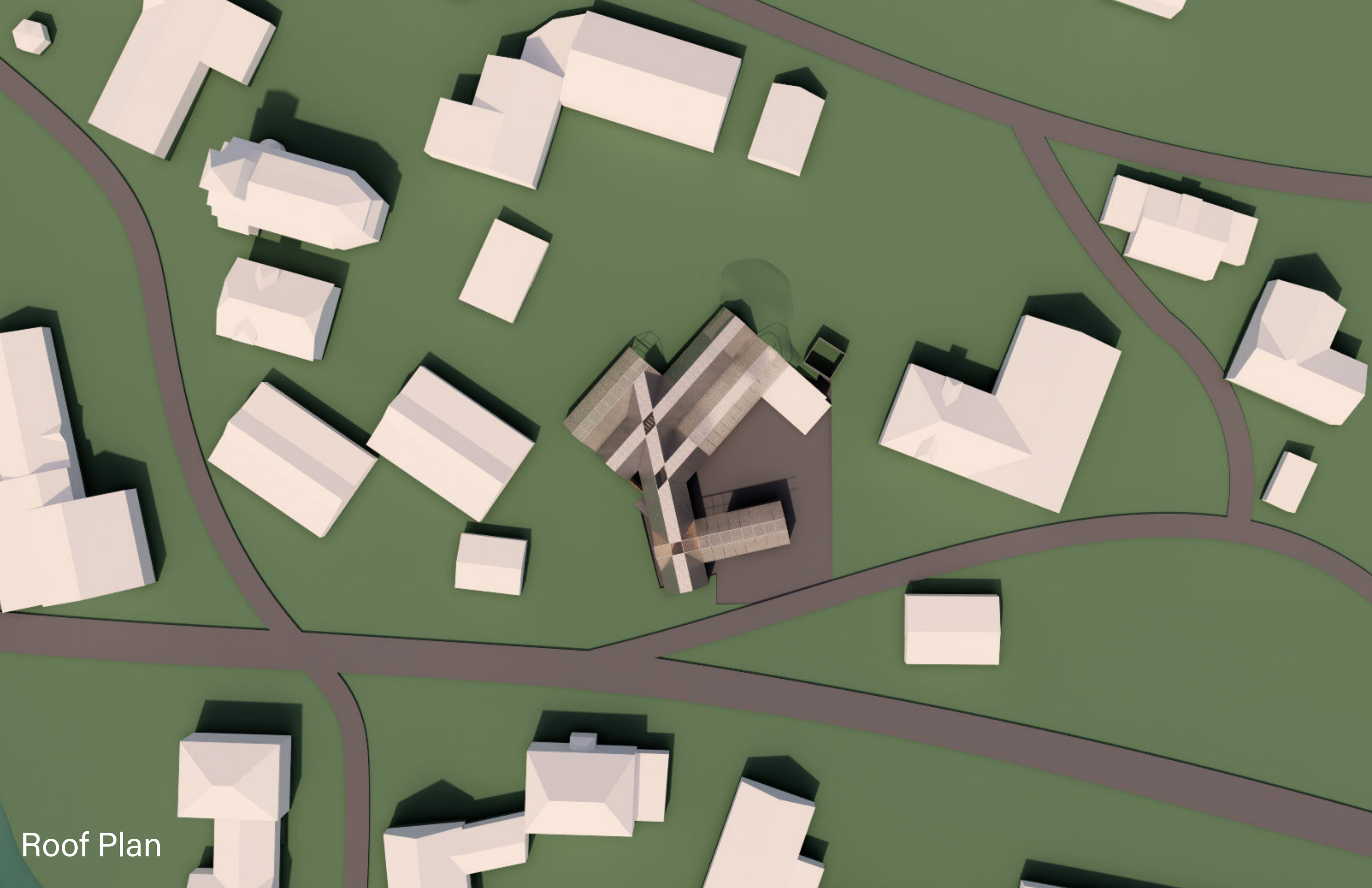

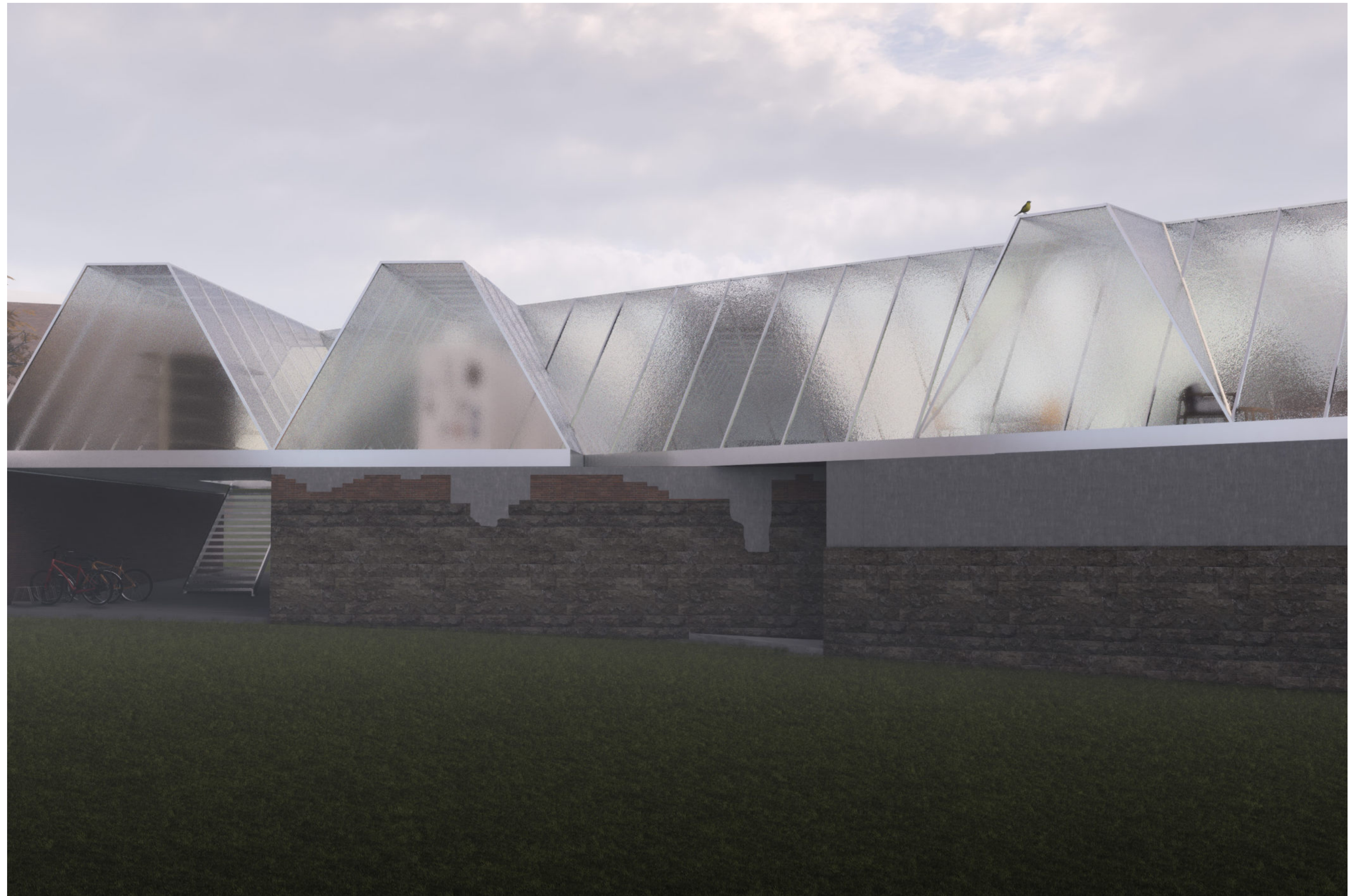

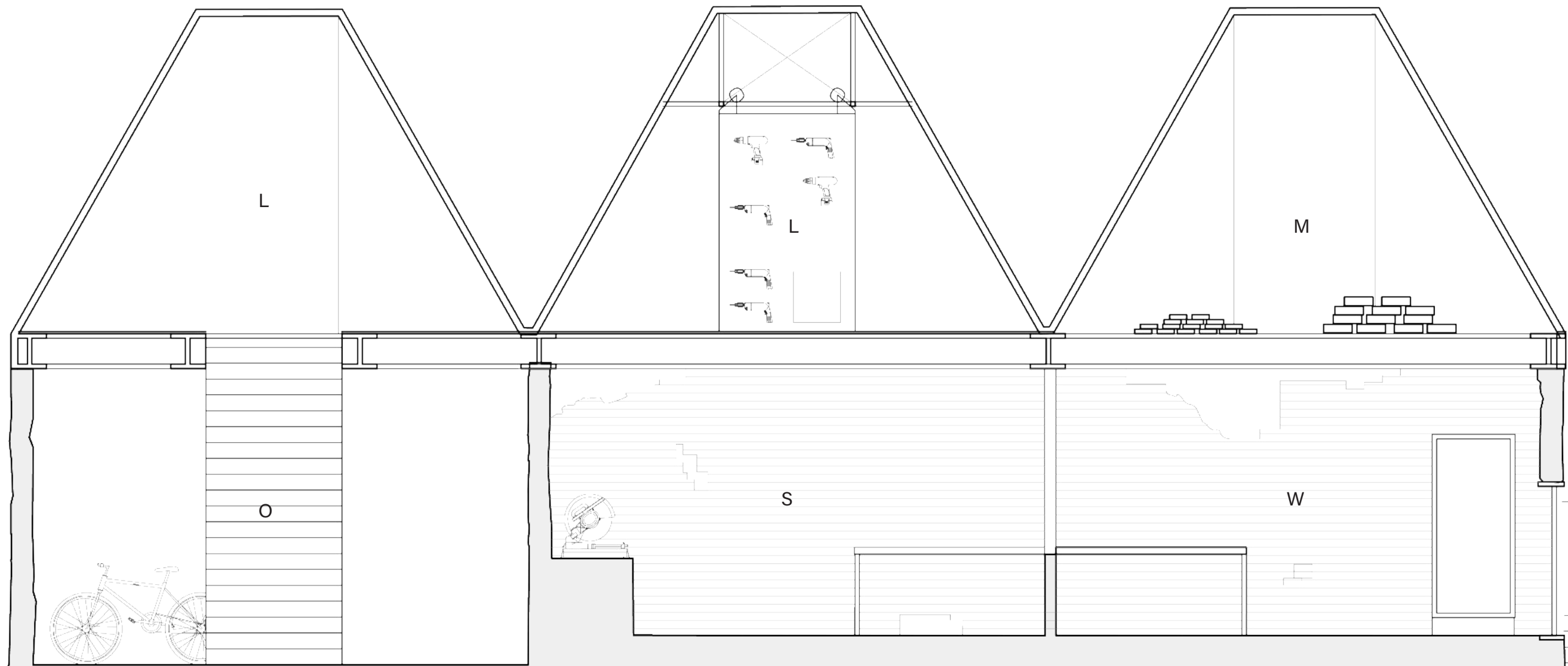




Roof Plan
